



### 1. DESCRIPTIVE ESSAY

**Show, Don't Tell** - Cover the sense organs, **create imagery** 


- 1) Standing near the blue ocean, I saw the beautiful sunset.

### 2. NARRATIVE ESSAY



- No in depth description but narration of a story
- Description of a surrounding
- Told from the person's view point
- Sensory details and colourful description
- May use dialogue

### 3. ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY



- Introduction of the topic
- Define
- Take Your Stand
- Add Supporting Points
- Refute the opposite stand

### 4. PICTURE COMPOSITION
